

## NORTHERN ASPHALT SURFACING HEAD OFFICE CAR PARK

AGGREGATE INDUSTRIES WAS ASKED TO SUPPLY SUPERCURVE ASPHALT FOR A CAR PARK DESIGNED TO ACCOMMODATE LARGE, HEAVY PLANT VEHICLES.

## THE BRIEF

When Northern Asphalt Surfacing needed a new solution for its 1200 sqm car park, a highly robust yet sustainable surfacing product that could withstand the daily rigours of wagons, vans and cars constantly turning was needed.

## THE SOLUTION

The layout and design of the car park, which wraps around the Northern Asphalt head office, meant that it was impossible to place a standard stone mastic asphalt (SMA) product and expect it to last with such demanding traffic.

An innovative material that surpassed the expectations of a conventional asphalt material was therefore required, and Aggregate Industries' SuperCurve, a high performance 10mm polymer modified asphalt, was chosen. Plus, SuperCurve is BBA HAPAS approved adding to its credibility for the job.

Encapsulating reliability, and costeffectiveness, SuperCurve is designed to withstand heavy and high-speed vehicles in transit and helps to prolong road life as well as minimising on-going maintenance costs. Plus, with its enhanced durability and extended life, it is a more sustainable choice.
